Celebrating the event

During the 11 days of competition Coomera will host the GC2018 Gymnastics competition and Netball Finals. These popular events will take place at the Coomera Indoor Sports Centre. This new, multi-purpose facility has a seating capacity of 7500.



Venue Construction

The centre will be closed to residents from 2 January for work to be carried out both inside and outside the venue.

Residents will first see a construction fence set up around the venue perimeter and an increased number of vehicles to the site. These vehicles will use the existing entrance on Beattie Road between 7am-5pm.

The surrounding sports fields and clubs will remain open and accessible for community use throughout this construction period until 22 March. Limited parking will remain during this time.

There will be local traffic changes in the weeks leading up to the Games.

What's happening in Coomera during GC2018?

The new, multi-purpose Coomera Indoor Sports Centre will host the Netball finals plus both the Artistic and Rhythmic Gymnastics events. There will be competition events at Coomera nearly every day of GC2018.

How will travel be affected?

The Coomera area will be busier than usual with:

- more people attending events
- increased traffic in the area
- heightened security measures
- increased use of public transport
- temporary road closures in place (refer to table)
- Games Route Network and Games Lanes in operation
- changes to parking and loading zones
- local area access permits potentially required.

Travel tips for you to consider

If you live, work or play in the area:

- Think about changing how you travel and try to minimise non-essential journeys where possible.
- If you can, walk or cycle local journeys under 45 minutes – it may be quicker.
- Check your public transport options.

- If you have to drive, allow extra time for your journey, re-route to avoid driving on the GRN and re-time your travel to less busy times.
- Attend one of our community drop-in sessions to help you understand and plan for local parking and access restrictions.
- If you work in the area, talk to your employer about flexible working arrangements e.g. working from home or flexible hours.

If you are a business owner:

- Attend a free Travel Advice for Business Workshop to help you understand and plan for impacts to your business operations.
- Consider how journeys made by your staff, visitors and customers could be impacted and how you can help minimise the impact on them.
- Re-time your freight, servicing and deliveries to less busy times and plan your journey in advance taking in to consideration temporary traffic changes.

About the Games Route Network in Coomera

The Games Route Network (GRN) is a series of designated roads linking the Commonwealth Games Village to all competition, non-competition venues and the airport and will offer safe, secure and reliable transport for athletes and officials.

It will operate 24 hours a day and will be busy at key times.

Some sections of the (GRN) known as Games Lanes will be reserved for public transport and official GC2018 and emergency vehicles. Games Lanes will operate on the Core GRN only and will be clearly marked and signed.



Games Lanes will be identified by signage and lane markings. Penalties will apply for unauthorised vehicles.
